Worksheets and their Use:

For VR Experience use the worksheet named VR Activity

Each topic has 2 types of Worksheets,

Worksheets 2 and 3 are cut-and-paste sheets that will be done in class under the supervision of the teacher.

Worksheet- 1, is a tracing sheet. can be done at home. **(Teacher can decide which worksheet to use in school and which one to send home)**

Sending a worksheet home is a good way of reinforcing what the child learned. It's a much-needed practice at home.

Note to the Teachers

Make sure the materials needed for the activities like Books, worksheets, crayons, printouts, flashcards, etc. are kept ready before the session begins. (Please keep in mind the count of the material will be as per the strength of the class).

Informational Text-

1. Apples are **one of the most widely grown tree fruit**.
2. Apple trees take **4 to 5 years to produce their first fruit**.
3. There are **more than 8,000 varieties** of apples – the largest variety of fruits to exist.
4. China is by far the largest apple producer.
5. Apples can help you **improve your memory**.
6. A **medium-sized apple** contains **80 calories**.
7. Apples **float in water** because they are **25% air**.
8. Apples can be eaten raw as well as cooked, With the skin and without the skin both.

Effective learning outcomes:

- Children demonstrate independence in activities.
- They follow instructions and simple rules at the same time
- Children exhibit fine motor skills with precision and control.
- They use a pincer grip (coordination of the index finger and thumb to hold an item) to hold and manipulate tools for drawing painting and writing
- They become effective Communicators.
- Recognition of letters and corresponding sounds
- Children become Involved Learners and Connect with their Immediate Environment
- They use all senses to observe and explore the environment
- Children notice and describe finer details of common objects, sounds, people, pictures, animals, and birds in the immediate environment.

Initiating teaching prompts

- As children learn new things about the fruit apple, the adult can make it an interactive session.
- A video (VR) on Apple, is a great way of learning the sound and gathering information about Apple.
- This experience will be enjoyable and exciting for the children.
- Encourage children to use words like seeds, crunchy, memory, healthy, and nutritious.
- Modulating your voice is a great way of capturing attention.
- Engage children in an interesting activity like (AR) that they will surely enjoy.
- Arts and crafts are one sure-shot way to have fun while they learn.
- As children will be learning a new word with the letter 'A', make it an interactive session, and start it in the following manner:

Hello children! What can you see on the screen?

Who am I, I live in the forests and in the polar region. I have thick shaggy hair, Yes! You guessed it right I am a Bear

"Aa" "Aa" Apple

Come on everyone, repeat after Bear. One last time "Aa" "Aa" Apple
