Worksheets and their Use:

Each topic has 3 types of Worksheets:

Worksheet-1 is a colouring sheet.

Worksheet-2 is a tracing sheet.

Worksheet-3 is a cut-and-paste sheet that can be done in class under the supervision of the teacher.

NOTE- it is completely the teacher's discretion, which worksheet she wants to make children do in the class, and which ones to be sent home

Sending a worksheet home is a good way of reinforcing what the child learned. It's a much-needed practice at home.

Instructions to run the AR/VR are on the page after the Table of Contents.

Note to the Teachers (Prepare your class)

Please make sure you have the materials needed for the activities in this session, preferably crayons, glue sticks, coloured papers, flashcards, printouts of worksheets, a projector, a laptop, a phone/tab, etc.

Preparing for the session is a good way to jump-start the session confidently. (Please keep in mind the count of the material will be as per the strength of the class).

Initiating teaching prompts

- As children learn a new number no. '9', the adult can make it an interactive session.
- A video (VR) of the number, is a great way of learning numbers and letters and gathering information about each object/character.
- This is an enjoyable and exciting experience for the children.
- Modulate your voice to capture attention.
- Engage children in an interesting activity like (AR) that they will surely enjoy.
- Arts and crafts are a sure-shot way to have fun while they learn.

Informational Text [For teachers use only]

- Enriching the development of a child's counting skills doesn't have to be complicated or time-consuming. The best counting activities are the ones that you can find in your day-to-day life. Screen time can be both fun and educational. The AR/VR activities are appropriate for young children who are just learning their numbers and older kids who would benefit from more of a challenge.
- 9 (nine) is a number, numeral.
- 9 is the ninth number in the number system,
- 9 is an odd number in the number system.
- The number 9 represents the quantity or the value of 9.

Instructions

- Children will learn to recognise the number 9 in order to be able to take their first step towards learning new and interesting math concepts, like before and after numbers, skip counting, etc.
- They need to learn the meaning of counting by using counting skills.
- Make it an interesting and interactive session.
- Give examples from day-to-day life.

Art/Craft/Fun Activities

Number 9 Balloons

Materials required- Lots of colourful balloons, and number nine stickers or markers to write the numbers (More number 9) on the balloons

Instructions- Blow the balloons, and stick or write numbers from 1 to 9 with the permanent markers. Children will be asked to find only the number 9 balloons out of all the balloons in 2 mins. Let the children enjoy & learn. Peppy music can be played in the background.

Recap questions-

- Give one example from the day-to-day life of the number you learnt today.
- Show the numbers using your finger.
- What did you colour today?
